Hints and Tips

- ★ Entries close 21 days before the area qualifier, late entries will not be accepted under any circumstances
- ★ If you are concerned call the office before the deadline to check on your entry. We cannot help you after entries have closed

- ★ Check declaration sheets as soon as they arrive with you and contact the office if there are any discrepancies

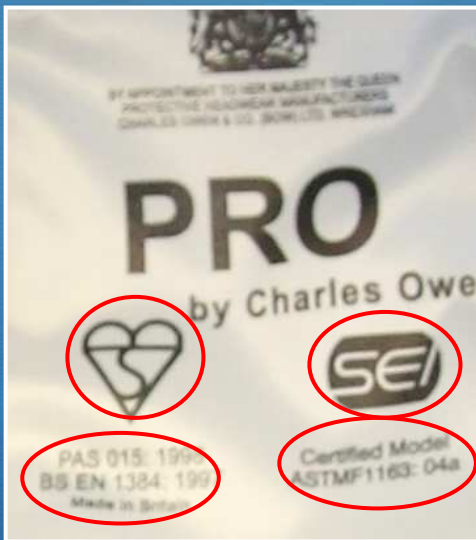
