BRC Assessments

- ☆ Progressive tests in both riding and horse welfare
Levels 1 -3 organised by the club, level 4 by BRC
- ☆ Available with and without jumping
- ☆ Translate into BHS stage exams: level 3 = stage 3
- ☆ Assessed by BHS instructors/registered BRC assessors

BRC Assessors

- ★ Assessors must attend an assessment day
- ★ Each assessor must complete a first aid and child protection course (not necessary for Riding Test and Style Jump Judges)
- ★ Refresher course must be attended every two years
- ★ Assessors examine up to the level they are assessed for
- ★ Level four assessors selected by BRC Training Committee

Horse Welfare Advisors

How to become a Horse Welfare Advisor

- ★ A candidate should hold at least one of the following:

Horse Welfare 2, BHS Stage 3, Pony Club B Test

- ★ Candidates must attend an assessment day and a refresher course every two years thereafter
- ★ At the discretion of the Master Judges, a candidate without the above qualifications may be accepted if they prove to have the necessary experience
