Ring 1. Show Jumping. From 10am

Class 1. Novice combination not to have been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd, jumps approx. 60cm in first round.

Class 2. Small Open, jumps approx. 70cm in first round.

Class 3. Open, jumps approx. 80cm in first round.

Class 4. Open jumping 90cm.

Class 5. Open 100cm. (If numbers permit)

To include David Broom Qualifiers (all classes)

Ring 2. Showing. From 9.30am

Class 6. Best turned out Horse/Pony and rider/handler. Ridden, lead or in hand.

Class 7. Best ridden/in hand/lead rein Veteran Horse/Pony, 15yrs or over.

Class 8. Best Coloured Horse/Pony, ridden/lead rein. Skewbald, Piebald, Appaloosa, Spotted, Palomino, Dunn.

Class 9. Lead Rein Pony, 122cm and under, rider 8yrs and under, snaffle bridle only.

Class 10. Mountain and Moorland ridden large or small.

Class 11. Child's First Pony, 128cm and under, rider 10yrs and under (no lead rein).

Class 12. Family Horse/Pony any type

Class 13. Competition Pony not exceeding 148cm. Small jump.

Class 14. Competition Horse exceeding 148cm Small jump.

(Class 13 and 14 may be amalgamated if lows numbers)

Rules.

All persons attending the event do so at their own risk and neither the Committee nor the Land Owners accept responsibility for any accident, loss or damage to any person, horse or property how so ever caused.

Classes 1 to 5 and 23 to 25 to be judged under Riding Club rules, a copy of which will be available at the Secretary's lorry.

In Classes 6 to 22 no rider may ride more than one horse/pony in a class.

Classes may be amalgamated or split depending on the number of entries.

Hats to at least **EN1384, PAS015** or prefixed with **ASTM or SEI** must be worn at all times while mounted, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. A body protector is strongly recommended for show jumping. This should be to Level 3 after 2000.

Anyone failing to comply with the Rules or Health and Safety Policy will be asked to withdraw.

Health and Safety.

All who attend the event are responsible for ensuring that they conduct themselves so that they do not put themselves or anyone else at risk.

Vehicles must be parked so as not to cause obstruction.

Members of the public are requested to keep clear of horse areas and to avoid behaviour which may alarm horses.

Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.

Class 15. Ex Racehorse Ridden (must have raced).

Class 16. Best Hack/Riding horse exceeding 148cm.

Championship.. For 1st and 2nd in all showing classes.

Ring 3. Hunter. From 9.30am

Class 17. Ridden Hunter, over 148cm.

Class 18. Cradle Stakes, 122cm and under, Working Hunter Pony (may be lead). Approx 45cm.

Class 19. Open Working Hunter, under 133cm. Approx 70cm.

Class 20. Open Working Hunter, 133cm to 153cm. Approx 75cm.

Class 21. Novice Working Hunter, over 153cm. Not to have won a working hunter class. Approx 75cm.

Class 22. Open Working Hunter, over 153cm. Approx 90cm.

Championship. For 1st and 2nd in all hunter classes.

Dressage. From 9am. Entries in advance only.

Class 23. Prelim 4 (2002)

Combination not to have been placed 1st dressage.

Class 24. Prelim 14 (2006) Open.

Class 25. Novice 28 (2008) Open.

David Broom Qualifiers in all classes

The Merely Diandz Trophy will be awarded to the combination of horse/pony and rider with the most points over classes 23 to 25 placed 1st to 6th.
