Class 1A Pre Introductory Practice Round – 55cm – NO FILLERS

Class 1 Introductory

Round 1 Fence Height 60cm, Round 2 Fence Height 65cm – NO FILLERS

This class is aimed at young horses/novice riders/inexperienced combinations.

NO pony/horse may be BS registered. Horse/pony must not have BS winnings. Horse / pony / combination MUST NOT have represented their Riding Club or Pony Club at Area at Combined Training, RWHS/FOTH Topscore /Novice SJ / 80cm Eventing or above and MUST NOT have won a show jumping competition at this height or above at close of entries.

Class 2A Pre Novice Practice Round – 65cm

Class 2 Pre Novice

Round 1 Fence Height 70cm, Round 2 Fence Height 75cm

**Combination MUST NOT have represented their Riding Club or Pony Club at Area at Combined Training, RWHS/ FOTH Topscore, Novice SJ / 80cm Eventing or above.

Horse/Pony may be BS registered but MUST NOT have winnings.

**Special dispensation to compete will be given to those Junior & Senior combinations who were eliminated in first round of BRC Area 12 Winter or Summer Novice SJ Qualifier

Each class will be open to Senior, Junior and Mixed Teams of 3 or 4 members from the same riding club (the best three scores will count).

Mixed Team entries will only be accepted from clubs unable to field complete Junior/Senior teams. Junior/Senior/Mixed Teams will be judged together. There is NO individual competition. Should a team be eliminated in Round 1 the complete team will, at the judges' discretion, be allowed to jump in Round 2.

Rosettes:- To first 6 teams in each class and to all competitors in Class 1. Sashes to winning teams

secretary@westsomersetridingclub.co.uk with any queries. **TIMES ARE GUIDE TIMES ONLY – TEAMS WILL JUMP IN THE ORDER STATED ON ENTRY FORM. PLEASE BE PROMPT / EARLY!** **There is no separate course walk for Class 2A - this will take place at same time as Round 2 of Class 1.**

RULES – Please read to avoid confusion!

Entries will be limited in each class.

Ages for Juniors as of 1st January 2015

All horses/ponies must be 4 years old or over.

No lunging allowed in warm up arena or lorry park.

This competition will be run under British Riding Club Show Jumping Rules 2015. The judges decision is final. Any competitor not adhering to the rules will be eliminated. **The practice fence must not exceed the height of the class in progress - this will be checked.**

Teams will jump en bloc two rounds only, the second round will be timed to decide minor placings. In the event of a tie for first place only, teams will jump a **third** round over a shortened course against the clock.

No rider may ride more than one horse/pony in any one team and no horse/pony may compete twice in the same class with different riders. **Only the person competing the horse may ride it on site and in the warm up arena.**

Declarations must be made at least half an hour prior to the commencement of the class by Team Managers to the Steward. Competitors are advised to bring their horse passports but vaccination records will not be checked.

Teams must present themselves en bloc **at least** 15 minutes before they jump for tack inspection. **It is the responsibility of individuals to familiarise themselves with the correct turnout requirements (particularly jewellery & hair) and permitted tack. BRC Rulebook 2015 can be viewed online – please ask if unsure.**

Protective helmets must be worn to current safety standards as detailed in British Riding Club Rulebook 2015. Competitors whose hats do not have a BRC turquoise hat tag must present for tack inspection un-mounted.

The wearing of body protectors is recommended.

The organisers reserve the right to alter/cancel classes at their discretion

Please leave the area around your horsebox/trailer/vehicle clean and tidy – if you can't see a wheelbarrow please ask !Sweep up all hay and pick up all horse manure – it is your responsibility to leave the site clean and tidy. Team managers please check !

Liability: Neither the landowners, organisers, nor any person acting on their behalf accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.

The organiser of the event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.

Please DO NOT bring dogs to the competition.
