Class 1 Introductory -

Dressage Tests :- BD Introductory A 2008
BD Introductory B 2009

This class is aimed at young horses/novice riders/inexperienced combinations.

NO pony/horse may be BD/BE registered. Horse/pony must not have BD/BE points.

Horse/ pony/combination MUST NOT have represented their Riding Club at any level Dressage or Horse Trials or Combined Training (including RWHS/ FOTH Qualifier) or represented their PC at Area Dressage or HT or qualified for the second round of the PC Dengie Winter League Dressage or scored 55% or above in BD Affiliated Prelim.

Class 2 Pre Novice

Dressage Tests :- BD Preliminary 4 2002
BD Preliminary 14 2006

Combination **MUST NOT** have represented their Riding Club at any level Dressage or Horse Trials or Combined Training (including FOTH Qualifier) or represented their PC at Area Dressage or HT or qualified for the second round of the PC Dengie Winter League Dressage or scored 58 % or above in BD Affiliated Prelim. Horse/Pony may be BD/BE registered but **MUST NOT** have BD/BE points.

Each class will be open to Senior, Junior and Mixed Teams of 3 or 4 members from the same club (the best three scores will count). Mixed Team entries will only be accepted from clubs unable to field complete Junior/Senior teams. Junior/Senior/Mixed Teams will be judged together.

In Class 1, two competitors will ride Intro A and two will ride Intro B. In Class 2, two competitors will ride Prelim 4 and two will ride Prelim 14. Teams of 3 must elect two riders for one test and one rider for the other.

RULES – Please read to avoid confusion!

Entries will be limited in each class.

Ages for Juniors as of 1st January 2015

All horses/ponies must be 4 years old or over.

No lunging allowed in warm up arena or lorry park.

This competition will be run under British Riding Club Dressage Rules 2015 .The judges decision is final. Any competitor not adhering to the rules will be eliminated.

Teams will compete in drawn order - rider one from each team, followed by rider two from each team etc. In Class 1, all Intro A competitors will ride, followed by all Intro B competitors. In Class 2 , all Preliminary 4 competitors will ride , followed by all Preliminary 14 competitors.

No rider may ride more than one horse/pony in any one team and no horse/pony may compete twice in the same class with different riders. **Horses/ponies/combinations may compete in BOTH classes as long as they meet entry criteria.**

Declarations must be made at least half an hour prior to the commencement of the class by Team Managers. Competitors are advised to bring their horse passports but vaccination records will not be checked.

Competitors must present themselves **on time/early** for tack inspection. **It is the responsibility of individuals to familiarise themselves with the correct turnout requirements and permitted tack as detailed in BRC Rulebook 2015**

Protective helmets with chinstrap fastened must be worn to current safety standards as detailed in British Riding Club Rulebook at all times when mounted. Only the person competing the horse may ride it on site and in warm up.

The organisers reserve the right to alter/cancel classes at their discretion

Please leave the area around your horsebox/trailer/vehicle clean and tidy – if you can't find a poop scoop or wheelbarrow please ask. REMOVE ALL HAY AND DROPPINGS - TEAM MANAGERS PLEASE CHECK

A limited number of day stables are available on a first come first served basis at a cost of £10 PLUS £10 caution money which will be refunded on the day, provided the stable is returned to a clean and tidy state after use. Please ask for poop scoop, wheelbarrow etc. **BOOK DIRECT WITH CONQUEST**
