Equifest Championships 2018

The two highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the relevant Equifest Championship to be held at the East of England Showground on the 8th – 12th August 2018.

South West Pony Association Championships 2018

This show is a qualifier for the South West Pony Association Championships to be held in September 2018, at The David Broome Event Centre, Crick, Gwent.

1. Enter one of the qualifying classes.
2. Be one of the two highest placed exhibits not already qualified within the first four and receive a qualification card signed in the ring.
3. Complete the entry form on the qualification card.
4. Return the card to together with any registration fees due within 14 days of this show.
Registration fee for 2018 is £25 to include all members of the family and equines owned by the family.

TSR Riders & In Hand Regional Finals

This show is a qualifier for the 2018 TSR Regional Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Regional Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/ Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Riders Finals - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Finals - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers **MUST** have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available **FREE** from the TSR website. Full details at www.theshowingregister.co.uk

Class 1 **BEST 1, 2 & 3 YEAR OLD** Mixed height and breeds. Stallion, Mare or Gelding.

Class 2 **EQUIFEST IN HAND RIDING PONIES** Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding. Any age, not to exceed 153cms at maturity. *Equifest Qualifier, SWPA Qualifier, TSR Qualifier.*

Class 3 **ASHFORD STABLES / EQUIFEST SHOW HUNTER PONY- LEAD REIN** Show Hunter Pony – Lead Rein, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Rider not to have attained their 9th Birthday before 1st January in the current year. *Equifest Qualifier, SWPA Qualifier, TSR Qualifier.*

To include CAVERNOMA ALLIANCE UK / EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LEAD REIN Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a Snaffle Bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only. *Equifest Qualifier, SWPA Qualifier, TSR Qualifier.*

- Class 4 **DAVEY'S LIVESTOCK TRANSPORT LTD / EQUIFEST SHOW PONY LEAD REIN**
Leading Rein Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over not exceeding 128cms.
Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only. *Equifest Qualifier, SWPA Qualifier, TSR Qualifier.*
- Class 5 **KBIS / EQUIFEST RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER PONIES** Show Hunter Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.
Equifest Qualifier, SWPA Qualifier, TSR Qualifier.
- TO INCLUDE EQUI-CHIP / EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND FIRST RIDDEN** Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.
Equifest Qualifier, SWPA Qualifier, TSR Qualifier.
- Class 6 **RUBY MARITIME SERVICES / EQUIFEST RIDDEN SHOW PONIES** Open Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 148cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.
Equifest Qualifier, SWPA Qualifier, TSR Qualifier.
- Championship 1-6 1st and 2nd placed horses**
Lunch Class 7 not before 1pm
- Class 7 **EQUIFEST INTERMEDIATE SHOW HUNTER TYPE** Open Intermediate Show Hunter Type, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year. *Equifest Qualifier, SWPA Qualifier, TSR Qualifier.*
- Class 8 **RIDDEN COMPETITION PONY.** Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over, not exceeding 148cms. Riders any age. *SWPA Qualifier*
- Class 9 **SENIOR HORSE or PONY** 16 years old and over In hand or Ridden. *SWPA Qualifier*
- Class 10 **IN-HAND TRADITIONAL COB,** Four & over. (Unplaited) Stallion, Mare or Gelding.
SWPA Qualifier, TSR Qualifier.
- Class 11 **NUPAFEEED / EQUIFEST RIDDEN COBS** Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms.
Equifest Qualifier, SWPA Qualifier, TSR Qualifier.
- TO INCLUDE HAYGAIN/EQUIFEST MAXI COBS** Open Maxi Cobs, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, exceeding 155cms – to be judged as Cobs. Riders any age. Riders any age. *Equifest Qualifier, SWPA Qualifier, TSR Qualifier.*
- Class 12 **RIDDEN TRADITIONAL COB.** (Unplaited) Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Riders any age. *SWPA Qualifier, TSR Qualifier.*
- Class 13 **RIDING CLUB HORSE / PONY.** Judged on Performance Freestyle Show and Suitability. Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over.

Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A and B. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. *Equifest Qualifier, SWPA Qualifier, TSR Qualifier.*
- Class 15 **SPILLERS / EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND IN HAND LARGE BREEDS**
Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C and D.

- Class 16 **IN-HAND SHETLAND.** Four & over. Stallion, Mare or Gelding. *SWPA Qualifier*
- Class 17 **IN HAND MINIATURE HORSE** Miniature Horse, registered with their respective Miniature Horse Society. Horse any age. Stallion, Mare or Gelding. *SWPA Qualifier*
- Class 18 **OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND SMALL BREEDS** Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A and B. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over.
Equifest Qualifier, SWPA Qualifier, TSR Qualifier.
- Class 19 **RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LARGE BREEDS** Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C and D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over.

- Class 20 **BSPA / EQUIFEST IN HAND PIEBALD / SKEWBALD** Open in Hand Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championships. Subject to their show rules & conditions. *Equifest Qualifier, SWPA Qualifier, TSR Qualifier.*
- Class 21 **IN HAND RARE/WORLD BREEDS** Mixed height, any age. Stallion, Mare or Gelding. (Excluding British Native Breeds, M&M Part Bred, Pure, Part Bred & Anglo Arabs)

- Class 22 **IN-HAND COMPETITION HORSE,** Four & over. Stallion, Mare or Gelding, exceeding 148cms.
SWPA Qualifier.
- Championship 14-22 1st and 2nd placed horses**
Lunch Class 23 not before 1pm
- Class 23 **BSPA / EQUIFEST RIDDEN PIEBALD / SKEWBALD** Open ridden Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Riders any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championship. Subject to their show rules & conditions. Native/Non-Native/Cob and Traditional, Stallion, Mare or Gelding, four years old and over. Skewbald, Piebald, Appaloosa, Spotted, Palomino And Dun.
Equifest Qualifier, SWPA Qualifier, TSR Qualifier.
- Class 24 **RIDDEN RARE/WORLD BREEDS** Mixed height, any age. Stallion, Mare or Gelding. (Excluding British Native Breeds, M&M Part Breds, Pure, Part Bred & Anglo Arabs).
SWPA Qualifier, TSR Qualifier.

Class 25 **RIDDEN RETRAINED RACE HORSE** Four years old and over. Judged 60% Performance to include Freestyle Show, and 40% Conformation. *SWPA Qualifier, TSR Qualifier.*

Class 27 **RIDDEN COMPETITION SPORT HORSE** Four years old and over. Judged 60% Performance to include Freestyle Show, and 40% Conformation, Classes may be split into not exceeding 148cms and exceeding 148cms. *SWPA Qualifier.*

Class 28 **PURE AND PART BRED RIDDEN IRISH DRAFT / CONNEMARA.** Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over. Riders any age.

Class 29 **BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES / EQUIFEST RIDDEN HUNTERS** Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cms. Riders any age.

To include CRABTREE AGRI SERVICES / EQUIFEST OPEN SMALL HUNTERS Open Small Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age. *Equifest Qualifier, SWPA Qualifier, TSR Qualifier.*

Class 30 **NUPAFEED / EQUIFEST RIDING HORSES** Open Riding Horse, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, any height. Riders any age.

To include HIGHTOPPS STUD / EQUIFEST RIDDEN HACKS Open Show Hacks, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 160cms. Riders any age. *Equifest Qualifier, SWPA Qualifier, TSR Qualifier.*

RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 1 Protective headgear, with the chin strap securely fastened, must be worn when mounted.
- 2 Dogs must be kept on non-retractable leads at all times whilst on the showground.
- 3 All animals will be considered and treated as being in the sole charge and custody of the exhibitor during the whole of the show and every exhibitor or his assistant must be in charge of same. The organisers will not be responsible for, or in respect of, any loss, damage, accident or injury, arising from accident or any other cause to any persons, stock, vehicles or equipment.
- 4 The organisers of this Show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards.
- 5 All stallions must be shown with a ribbon in its tail.
- 6 All competitors and spectators attend at their own risk. The landowners, organisers or officials will not hold themselves responsible for any loss, damage, accident or injury to owners, handlers, spectators, livestock or any property or vehicle, however caused.
- 7 The organisers reserve the right to vary the order or composition of the schedule according to circumstances and to substitute other judges from those named, or to make additional appointments as required. The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate or sub-divide any class should numbers entered justify it.
- 8 Do not muck out lorries and trailers onto the carpark, please use the bins provided or take muck and litter home, thank you.
- 9 The decision of the organisers on any point not covered by the rules is final.
