Save for death or injury caused by the negligence of the landowner or officials of West Somerset Riding Club for which they are legally responsible, the landowners and officials will not accept any liability for any accident, loss, injury, illness or damage to competitors, property, vehicles, animals or spectators of any description. This event is covered by British Riding Club's insurance but competitors are advised to hold their own personal injury insurance cover. It is the responsibility of non BRC members to ensure they have public liability insurance. The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to safeguard the health and safety of everyone present. For these to be effective, competitors and spectators are required to take due care at all times and to obey any notices or requests made by official stewards in the interests of their own and others' safety.

Hard hats must be worn at all times when mounted and securely fastened. Hats should be at least the minimum standard with harness properly adjusted and fastened. Hats MUST be marked PASO15:1998/2011/VGI 01.040 2014-12 plus BSI kite mark or SNELL E2001 or ASTM F1163 2004a/04a plus SEI mark or AS/NZS 3838: 2006 plus SAI global mark. Hats with EN 1384 plus BSI kite mark alone are no longer permitted under BRC rules - if unsure, ask prior to competing.

Dress & tack must be in accordance with BRC rules 2018. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure they meet these requirements. Any queries - please ask before competing.

The organiser reserves the right to alter the schedule or advertised start time, refuse any entry, cancel any class should conditions be or become unsuitable, amalgamate classes or close classes at their discretion.

Any person using physical or verbal abuse against any committee member, judge, steward, official, helper or other competitor will be asked to leave the showground and banned from entering the show in the future.

The judges' decision is final in all matters. Objections must be made to the Secretary within 15 minutes of the results or incident with a £10 deposit. The deposit will be reimbursed if the objection is upheld.

All ridden horses/ponies must be 4 years old and over. Horses/ponies must not be galloped outside the rings or in the warm up area. Please work within the designated warm up area only. Anyone riding or handling a horse/pony in a manner that is considered by the organisers to endanger the safety or wellbeing of any horse, pony, rider, spectator or official will be asked to leave the showground. Stallion discs must be worn.

No lunging allowed in warm up area or car/lorry park. Only the person/s competing the horse/pony may ride it on site and in the warm-up area and only in the tack in which the pony/horse is going to be competed. Only ponies/horses competing at the event are allowed in the warm-up or to be exercised on site.

STALLIONS & COLTS that are 2yrs old and over must be in possession of a current licence and be shown bitted with stallion discs clearly attached to the bridle. If being shown in hand, stallions & colts may not be led by any handler who has not attained their 14th birthday. Ridden stallions not exceeding 138cm may not be ridden by anyone who has not attained their 12th birthday. Stallions exceeding 138cm may not be ridden by anyone who has not attained their 14th birthday.

All ages to be taken as on the day of the show unless otherwise stated.

Horses/ponies must not be tied up outside lorry/trailer and <u>left unattended</u> or tied up to any fencing. Please clean up the manure and hay from the area around your horsebox/ trailer and take it home with you or find the muck heap. Please take your litter home or put in bins.

Please ensure both you and your horse meet the criteria for "bona fide amateur, novice or unaffiliated rider " as defined on the Sunshine Tour website www.sunshinetour.co.uk

Please keep dogs on a lead at all times, including around the parking area
