Up to 35 Novice points, 0 Elementary points or above

Class 1A – Area only (as above)

Class 2Q Novice 28 (2008) – team and individual

Unlimited Novice points, up to 35 Elementary points, 0 Medium points

Class 2A – Area only (as above)

Class 3Q Novice 34 (2009) – team and individual

Unlimited Novice points, up to 35 Elementary points, 0 Medium points

Class 3A – Area only (as above)

Class 4Q Elementary 42 (2008) – team and individual

Unlimited Elementary points, up to 35 medium points, 0 points at Adv Med or above.

Class 4A – Area only (as above)

Class 5Q Pick A Test Medium 71 (2002) / Advanced Medium 90 (2012) – individual

Unlimited Adv Med points, up to 35 PSG points, 0 points at Inter I or above

Class 5A – Area only (as above)

N.B. For the Intermediate TEAM competition, (both qualifier and area only) each member of the team of 4 rides a different dressage test from classes 1-4. Team members must all be current senior members. Individuals for all classes must be current senior members.

ENTRY FEE : £48 per team. £12 per individual. Qualifying prelim entries to be made using the official BRC Entry form or website by 7th October 2018. Detailed entries with payment to be sent to the Secretary on the BRC Area Entry form by 23rd October 2018. All cheques should be made payable to "West Somerset Riding Club" and have the name of the team(s) and club printed clearly on the reverse side, One cheque per club please. A charge of £10 will be made for any dishonoured cheques. BACS payments can be made to WSRC. DECLARATIONS Qualifier declaration sheets to be handed in together with all photocopies of passport/flu vacc pages in a clear plastic sleeve (one per team) prior to first horses competing. Hats must be tagged with BRC tag or checked and tagged before mounting. Bring to the Secretary when you collect your number. See current rulebook / BRC website for details. ELIGIBILITY AND RULES

Riders may compete in the same class as an individual AND as a team member provided different horses/ponies are ridden. NO Entry will be accepted without correct and full payment at close of entry and all clubs must also have paid affiliation fees before entries will be accepted. Please note vaccination rules for qualifying entries and rule G7.3 regarding disqualification.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.

All persons **must** wear a riding hat/helmet to current **UK Safety Standards as detailed in BRC rulebook** whilst mounted at all times
