*Unlimited Prelim Points; 0 points at Novice or above*

Class 4n Dressage - Novice 24(2010) - Open (seniors and non-qualifying juniors)

*Unlimited Novice Points; Up to 35 Elementary Points; 0 points at Medium or above*

*Unlimited Novice Points; Up to 35 Elementary Points; 0 points at Medium or above*

*Unlimited Elementary Points; Up to 35 Medium Points 0; points at Adv. Medium or above*

Class 10n Dressage - Pick A Test Medium 71(2002) or Advanced Medium 90 (2012) –  
Open (seniors and non-qualifying juniors)

Class 10q Dressage - Pick A Test Medium 71(2002) or Advanced Medium 90 (2012) –  
Qualifier (juniors only)

*Unlimited Medium Points; Up to 35 total points at Advanced Medium or above  
Unless choosing AM90 where you can have unlimited Advanced Medium points*

## Entering

Entry fees: £48 per team of 3 or 4; £12 per individual. Entries via Equo but qualifying entries **MUST** be additionally submitted on the official entry form (available [www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-downloads](http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-downloads))

Entries to 'q' section of classes **MUST** also have paid their Preliminary Entry Fee either direct to BRC Head Office or using the BRC online system. Closing date for preliminary entries November 10, 2018.

Teams for Novice Dressage must be 3 or 4 riders, one person riding in each of classes 2-5 (best 3 scores to count) – championships are 30/31 March 2019, Grantham, Lincolnshire.

Teams for Intermediate Dressage must be 3 or 4 riders, one person riding in each of classes 6-9 (best 3 scores to count) and individuals in Class 10 – championships are 26-28 April 2019, Slapton, Buckinghamshire.

Qualifying teams must be all-Junior; non-qualifying teams may be senior, or mixed junior/senior. (It is quite in order for a non-qualifying team to include qualifying junior individuals).

Members of teams are automatically eligible for individual awards in addition to their Team awards.

Classes and scoring will be run in accordance with 2018 British Riding Club handbook (free to download). These notes are an incomplete summary only, for convenience.

Riders may ride in the same class twice, as an individual and as a team member, provided different horses are ridden.

Horses may be ridden twice, ie in different qualifying classes, provided only one is as part of a team. (Rule 6.3) (non-qualifying or 'warm-up' entries will be ignored, however a horse is not permitted to ride the same test twice)

For the purposes of how many times can riders or horses compete, classes 2q-5q and 6q-10q are considered separate Qualifiers because they are for quite separate Championships.

Times will be available evening of Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> November, on BRC Area 12 website.

Qualifying entries – Declaration forms and copies of equine flu vac records must be handed in **BEFORE** numbers are collected. Originals must be available for inspection and **MUST** be submitted, before prizegiving for winning and runner-up teams and individuals. Failure to produce will result in disqualification - you have been warned! (Rule G7.2)

## **Scoring**

For the purposes of overall Class placings, all scores from section 'n' and section 'q' will be considered together (ie everybody riding a particular Test will be competing against each other). For the purpose of Qualifier placings, ONLY section 'q' will be considered; a separate set of placings will then be announced, and a separate set of rosettes awarded.

Teams will be scored using best 3 placings of team members. Individuals will be removed and the placing order recalculated. Placings from both 'n' and 'q' sections will be considered to derive the Novice team placings and the Intermediate team placings. For the purpose of Qualifier team placings, ONLY section 'q' team members will be considered; a separate set of Team placings will then be announced, and a separate set of Team rosettes awarded. (CR Appendix 11b)

Awards will be made 30 minutes after posting of results. Protests must be made in writing, within 30 minutes of the incident or announcement of results, accompanied by £20 deposit, which will be returned if the protest is upheld or it was agreed that there were good reasons for making protest. (Rule G14)

Highest placed qualifying team will be put forward for qualification. In addition, the highest placed individual (not part of a qualifying team) for each test will be put forward for qualification. (CR Appendix 10a)

## **General**

Competitors are reminded to keep parking area tidy and to pick up droppings (pooper scoopers will be available on-site for this purpose)
