**STYLE JUMPING CLASSES (To be run on grass)**

Style Jumping is for both senior and junior riders. It is open to teams of four riders and to individuals. Each team consists of two riders jumping a 75cm course and two riders jumping an 85cm course on grass. Individuals may choose. Riders jump one round and are judged on the style of their riding. See the BRC Handbook for full details.

<b>Class 1</b> To be run on grass	NAF Summer ( <b>Junior and Senior</b> ) Style Jumping 75cm ( <b>Regional &amp; National Qualifier</b> ) Team and Individual	Horses may be registered with BE and BS but must not have any points (Other than notional points gained in 70cm and 80 cm classes held at BS Intro shows. BS Club points gained at any level will not be counted except for 70cm SJ.)
<b>Class 2</b> To be run on grass	NAF Summer ( <b>Junior and Senior</b> ) Style Jumping 85cm ( <b>Regional &amp; National Qualifier</b> ) Team and Individual	Horses must not have more than 10 BE point and/or 225 BS but must not have any points (Other than notional points gained in 70cm and 80 cm classes held at BS Intro shows. BS Club points gained at any level will not be counted except for 70cm SJ.)

**SHOW JUMPING CLASSES (First round on grass, second round on arena)**

<b>Class 3a</b> First round on grass, second round on arena	NAF Summer ( <b>Junior</b> ) Show Jumping ( <b>National Qualifier</b> ) Team and Individual Max height 1st round: 70cm	Open to members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. Horses or ponies not to have won any BS (or BS Club) points gained at 90cm or higher. Horses may not have been placed in the top six at BE 90 or to have completed a BE 100 or above in the current or previous calendar year at close of prelim entry. Horses may not have competed at BRC HT 90 or above in the same competition year.
<b>Class 3b</b> First round on grass, second round on arena	NAF Summer ( <b>Senior</b> ) Show Jumping ( <b>National Qualifier</b> ) Team and Individual Max height 1st round: 70cm	Open to members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. Horses or ponies not to have won any BS (or BS Club) points gained at 90cm or higher. Horses may not have been placed in the top six at BE 90 or to have completed a BE 100 or above in the current or previous calendar year at close of prelim entry. Horses may not have competed at BRC HT 90 or above in the same competition year.

Classes 3 a & b will be run together but scored separately.

<b>Class 4a</b> First round on grass, second round on arena	NAF Summer ( <b>Junior</b> ) Show Jumping ( <b>Regional &amp; National Qualifier</b> ) Team and Individual Max height 1st round: 80cm	Open to members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. Horses or ponies not to have won any BS points (other than notional points gained in 70cm and 80 cm classes held at BS Intro shows. BS Club points gained at any level will not be counted except for 70cm SJ). Horses may be currently registered with BE but must not have been placed in the first six in any BE 100 competition or completed BE 105 or above in the current or previous calendar year at close of prelim entry, and have no more than 1 BE point.

<b>Class 4b</b> First round on grass, second round on arena	NAF Summer ( <b>Senior</b> ) Show Jumping ( <b>Regional &amp; National Qualifier</b> ) Team and Individual Max height 1st round: 80cm	Open to members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. Horses or ponies not to have won any BS points (other than notional points gained in 70cm and 80 cm classes held at BS Intro shows. BS Club points gained at any level will not be counted except for 70cm SJ). Horses may be currently registered with BE but must not have been placed in the first six in any BE 100 competition or completed BE 105 or above in the current or previous calendar year at close of prelim entry, and have no more than 1 BE point.

Classes **4 a & b** will be run together but scored separately.

<b>Class 5a</b> First round on grass, second round on arena	NAF Summer ( <b>Junior</b> ) Show Jumping ( <b>National Qualifier</b> ) Team and Individual Max height 1st round: 90cm	Open to members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. Horses or ponies not to have won more than 500 BS points (other than notional points gained in 70cm and 80 cm classes held at BS Intro shows. BS Club points gained at any level will not be counted except for 70cm SJ). Horses must not have more than 20 BE points.
<b>Class 5b</b> First round on grass, second round on arena	NAF Summer ( <b>Senior</b> ) Show Jumping ( <b>National Qualifier</b> ) Team and Individual Max height 1st round: 90cm	Open to members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. Horses or ponies not to have won more than 500 BS points (other than notional points gained in 70cm and 80 cm classes held at BS Intro shows. BS Club points gained at any level will not be counted except for 70cm SJ). Horses must not have more than 20 BE points.

Classes **5a & b** will be run together but scored separately.

<b>Class 6</b> First round on grass, second round on arena	NAF Summer ( <b>Junior and Senior</b> ) Show Jumping ( <b>National Qualifier</b> ) Team and Individual Max height 1st round: 1m	This is a mixed class open to senior and junior teams and individuals, teams may be any combination of senior and/or junior. Horses or ponies not to have won more than 999 BS points (other than notional points gained in 70cm and 80 cm classes held at BS Intro shows. BS Club points gained at any level will not be counted except for 70cm SJ). Horses must not have more than 60 BE points.
<b>Class 7</b> First round on grass, second round on arena	NAF Summer ( <b>Junior and Senior</b> ) Show Jumping ( <b>National Qualifier</b> ) Team and Individual Max height 1st round: 1.10m	This is a mixed class open to senior and junior teams and individuals, teams may be any combination of senior and/or junior. There are no limits to the horses BS or BE points.

Riders jump two rounds. All rounds are timed, with the second round timing will be used to determine minor placings when faults cannot do this. If there is still an equality for first place after the second round then there will be a jump off against the clock. The best three scores in each round will count for the total score.

See current rule book for full Eligibility of Horses and Riders.

The same horse cannot be used for the Senior and Junior sections.

Horse may only compete at one height in a competition year. Riders may compete in the same class as an individual AND as a team member provided different horses/ponies are ridden.

All junior members must be under 18 years of age on the 1st January 2019.

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with the current BRC Rulebook.

Late non-qualifying entries may be accepted with a late surcharge of £20 per team at the discretion of the organiser if there are sufficient spaces. Late entries cannot be guaranteed and must not be paid for unless approval from the organiser has been sought.

**Declarations;**

Qualifier declaration sheets to be handed in together with all photocopies of passport/fluovac pages in a clear plastic sleeve (one per team) prior to first horse competing on that day.

Hats must be checked before mounting. Bring to the Secretary when you collect your number if not already tagged with a current AQUA (2018) Tag. See current rulebook / BRC website for details.
