Criteria

To be ridden in a 20m x 40m arena. Set out with appropriate markers.

The majority of the test to be ridden as a pair (80% of test) but may separate.

Time allowed 4 – 4.5 minutes.

Any movements used must be at BD Introductory Level, but not above.

The test starts and finishes with salutes. The time is started at the first salute.

Entering

Entry fees: £60 per team of 3 or 4; £16 per individual; £20 per pair. Entries to be submitted using attached form (use as many as necessary).

Qualifying entries of classes MUST also have paid their Pre-entry using the BRC online system, 21 days before the Qualifier (closing date for pre-entries Sept 29, 2023).

Teams must be 3 or 4 riders, one person riding in each of classes 3-6 (best 3 scores to count)

Qualifying teams must be all-Junior or all-Senior; non-qualifying teams may be senior, or mixed junior/senior. (It is quite in order for a non-qualifying team to include one or more qualifying individuals, if those individuals have submitted a BRC pre-entry).

Members of teams are automatically eligible for individual awards in addition to their Team awards.

Pairs classes are senior, junior, or mixed – there is no distinction based on age.

Classes and scoring will be run in accordance with 2023 British Riding Club handbook (free to download). These notes are an incomplete summary only, for convenience.

Riders may ride in the same class twice, as an individual and as a team member, provided different horses are ridden.

Horses may be ridden twice, ie in different qualifying classes, provided only one is as part of a team. A horse may not ride the same course, or the same dressage test with same judge, more than once per day; be competitively ridden by more than two people per day; or have more than four ridden competition efforts per day.

Late entries – contact organiser to ask.

Times will be available evening of Thursday 19th October, on South Molton & District Facebook page.

Qualifying entries – Copies of equine flu vac records, showing complete course of vaccinations from the initial primary injections, must be emailed. Originals must be available on the day.

Scoring

Teams will be scored using best 3 placings of team members. Individuals will be removed and the placing order recalculated, to assess overall team penalties (see 2023 Handbook, Appendix 11B).

Awards will be made 30 minutes after posting of results. Protests must be made in writing, within 30 minutes of the incident or announcement of results, accompanied by £20 deposit, which will be returned if the protest is upheld or it was agreed that there were good reasons for making protest.

Results for qualifying entries (teams, pairs, individuals) will be submitted to Head Office for selection of qualifying entries for the Championships at Bury Farm Equestrian Village, Bedfordshire.

General

This competition will be run on a surface, as will the Championships at Bury Farm Equestrian Village.

Number of riders will be limited in the warm up, on entry to the warm up arena please report to the dressage and tack stewards.

Correct dress must be worn (see BRC Handbook). Hats must be tagged (pink) – hat tagging will be available on the day.

Tests may be called (however, Commanders must read the official test-sheet text, and nothing more).

Competitors must provide their own number (bib front and back, or bridle/saddle numbers each side, are acceptable).

Competitors are reminded to keep parking area tidy and to pick up droppings (pooper scoopers will be available on-site for this purpose).
